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INDIAN FEDERATION ELECTS NEW PRESIDENT AS 21 COACHES ATTEND CCP LEVEL 1 COURSE



Sandhya Palikar has been elected President of the Modern Pentathlon Federation of India (MPFI) and will serve a four-year term from 2022-26.
